1. Call meeting to order - Sarah Monahan called the meeting to order. May 1st , 2018, North Ridgeville Library

3. Treasurer Report - We have \$5800 (without KK) in our account. We should have about \$3000 more after KK.

4. School Delegate Report - _ Grants from the Edowment funds were distributed, \$14,570. Second largest amount to be awarded.

10. Membership - Ice Cream Social is being planned at Diary Grove. Kids will get tickets for ice cream as well as a NRECHPTA t shirt. If parking will be an issue we can park in the Chemical Bank parking lot. Flyers for this event will be passed at the Memorial Day Parade. Also looking to order adult PTA shirts that will be an out of pocket expense.
11. Fundraising - Planning to do a Mitchell's Gift Card fundraiser that would be perfect for a teacher's gift.
12. Kiddie Kloset - New Signs have been ordered (\$400) Next Kiddie Kloset will be in October.

We made \$1411.78 from selling the tables, \$876 from admission and raffle, \$171 from bake sale.

It was discussed to do a 50/50 raffle for next year. Sellers that have more than the allowed 6 items per table could "buy" more spots. It was also talked to get some highschool volunteers to help out.
